*Dear Potential Contributor,*

*As a result of the excellent Fault-Related Folding Conference in Beijing in Late June and the field trip to the Tianshan we are gathering key papers for publication in an AAPG Memoir which has now been approved by the AAPG Publications Board. The Memoir will total approximately 400 pages and there will be the possibility of an accompanying CD to include additional material.*

***Deadline for submission of manuscripts – EXTENDED TO - NOVEMBER 30th.***

***Files must be submitted as pdf files in AAPG Bulletin Format (see attached files) Please do not e-mail files over 10 Mb in size as they will clog the system – reduce file size first using Photoshop etc.***

***The Third Circular will give details of submission procedures once our website has been established***

### **MEMOIR CONTENTS**

It is proposed that the Memoir be divided into the following themes. -

1. Theoretical and Conceptual Models
2. Analog and Numerical Models
3. Active Thrust Fault-Related Fold Systems
4. Case Studies

- a) Western China – Tarim and Jungaar Basins
- b) Deepwater Fold Belts
- c) Basement-Involved Fault-Related Fold Systems
- d) Other Foreland Fold Belt Systems (including the Pyrenees, the Zagros, the Rocky Mountains, Taiwan).

**Points to Note –**

- 1. Papers will all be new research work, including those with a view to application to Hydrocarbon Exploration and Production. Large sections of material previously published will not be accepted.**
- 2. All papers will be subject to rigorous peer review with at least 3 international reviewers.**
- 3. Invitation to submit a paper does not necessarily imply acceptance for publication. Subject to item 2 above, the editors reserve the right to accept or reject any paper submitted for consideration for this Memoir.**
- 4. The deadline for submission of manuscripts will be **NOVEMBER 30<sup>TH</sup> 2005**. Electronic submission will be pdf files via e-mail (file sizes less than 10 Mb), reviewing and corrections will be carried out using a website that we will set up. Please ensure that your manuscripts, references and figures conform to the AAPG Bulletin styles and formatting as indicated in the attached files.**
- 5. Paper Sizes: Due to limitations of space ~ 400 printed pages in total we will be looking for concise well-illustrated manuscripts that will typically be in the range of 12 – 16 printed pages including figures, tables and references. See AAPG Bulletin for approximate sizes - ~ 12 – 16,000 words plus 12 – 18 figures maximum. Authors are requested to carefully review their manuscripts before submission so that they meet these requirements as closely as possible. Over long papers will be returned to authors for reduction before review.**
